Empowerment Project is a catalyst for change, creating pathways for women to lead and inspire meaningful transformation.

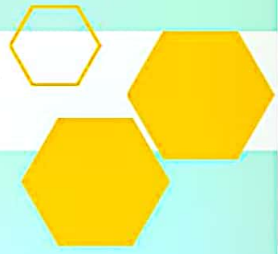

Child Protection Awareness Program

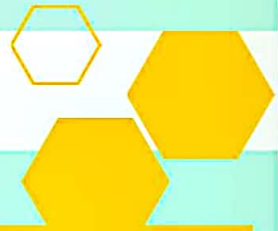
